Westin New York at Times Square Unveils Renovation

The Westin New York at Times Square, which was the first Westin hotel in New York City over a decade ago, has completed a \$33 million, top-to-bottom renovation encompassing its guest rooms and corridors, as well as its meeting space, it announced yesterday.

"We are extremely proud that our hotel has fast become an iconic, modern-day oasis in one of New York City's busiest neighborhoods," General Manager Sean Verney said in a statement. "We are diligent about continually updating and improving the guest experience to guarantee we live up not only to our world-class location, but our

brand promise of ensuring guests leave feeling better than when they arrived."

The three-year, multi-phase renovation added 10 new premium deluxe guest rooms to the property, which now has 873 guest rooms, each of which has been updated with new furniture, carpeting, and wall coverings, and with a redesigned guest bathroom. The hotel also added new carpeting, wall coverings, and artwork in guest room corridors; converted 65 king rooms to two-bedded rooms capable of accommodating families; and completely renovated all 34,000 square feet of available meeting and pre-function space.

"The Westin New York at Times Square has been a key part and performer within our portfolio since its inception," said Robert Snyder, president of Tishman Hotel Corp., the property's owner. "We are committed to continuous improvements and investments to keep the hotel top-of-mind as the leader within its competitive set. The renovation was meticulously planned and executed. We are thrilled with the results and have already received tremendous feedback from our guests."
